Landcheck data available to view this afternoon

Homeowners on the Port Hills will be able to check their individual property status from 1pm today once the website www.landcheck.org.nz comes back online.

Yesterday 1600 homes in the Port Hills were rezoned from white to green, meaning they were able to get on with the process of rebuilding and repairing their homes.

Letters have been sent to homeowners today, explaining the process involved in the rezoning. Those letters have gone to people who have just been rezoned, as well as people in the white and orange zones who have yet to have their land reclassified.

Yesterday's zoning changes mean more than 11,300 properties in the Port Hills area are now zoned green, with about 2100 homes remaining in the white zone.

CERA is continuing to work with the Christchurch City Council and EQC to rezone these properties as well as the 900 properties still in the orange zone.

Orange zone residents can expect a decision on their land early in the New Year.
