Official Information Act request relating to reimbursements of eligible emergency costs

Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) request received on 26 June 2018. You requested:

*"Centralised claim information from November 2017 to present.
Information on Cabinet funding decisions for emergency management from 2004 to present, including: event, year local authority, amount paid, funding stream. If this data includes a description of the impacts (e.g. debris removal, flooded pump station, etc) that would definitely be of interest too. Rejected claims are also of interest."*

On 24 July 2018, Officials from the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet wrote to you extending your request, and seeking clarification on the information you wished to receive, resulting in the above revised request.

Note 1: total ineligible costs identified in this claim was \$417,818.08, the original claim also includes a sum of \$1,059,850.61 for the cost of projects yet to be approved in the programme during the time of claim validation process. A total of \$29,359.28 requires further information from the Council to determine the eligibility. The Bay of Plenty Regional Council's threshold is \$1,038,880.

Reimbursement amount = (2,840,258.33-417,818.08-1,059,850.61-29,359.28-1,038,880)*0.6=176,610.20

Note 2: total ineligible costs identified in this claim was \$161,932.27. Hurunui District Council threshold is \$436,926

Reimbursement amount = (1,007,788.80-161,932.27-436,926)*0.6=245,358.32

Note 3: total original claim is made up with \$317,369.01 for welfare costs and \$3,634,015.49 for other response and recovery costs. DPMC identified a total of \$245,598.57 was eligible for welfare cost (100% Crown contribution) and \$513,771.12 was eligible for other response and recovery costs (60% Crown contribution). As the total eligible other response/recovery cost is below Whakatane District Council's threshold of \$684,207.65, Crown only reimbursed WDC for the eligible welfare costs which is \$245,598.57.
