Official Information Act request relating to advertising costs for the Unite Against COVID-19 public education campaign

Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) request, which was transferred from the Minister of Finance, Hon Grant Robertson on 6 August 2020. You requested:

"How much (money wise) has it cost the Govt in advertising (in papers/TV) for COVID-19 up to 31 July 2020."

As at 31 July 2020, the advertising cost of the Unite Against COVID-19 public education campaign was \$19,103,412.32 (GST exclusive). The advertising for the public education campaign includes TV, national and regional newspapers (hard copy and digital), all major radio networks and community stations (sector specific), digital advertisements on key social channels and Out of Home advertisements (e.g. billboards, bus stops and footpaths), and target advertising for speakers of other languages.
