### **GOVERNOR-GENERAL'S TRAVEL TO SAMOA**

#### Proposal

1 Cabinet is asked to note that the Governor-General, Her Excellency The Rt Hon Dame Cindy Kiro, will travel to Samoa from 4 to 8 September 2022.

#### Summary

- 2 At the invitation of the Prime Minister, the Governor-General undertakes a programme of international travel, representing New Zealand in the Head of State role (Cabinet Manual 2017, paragraph 1.13).
- 3 The principal purpose of the visit is for the Governor-General to attend the 60th Anniversary of Independence official celebrations events, which were deferred from June 2022, and to visit Savai'i (Samoa's largest island) which was last visited by a New Zealand senior representative in 2013, to support the strong partnerships with New Zealand and inclusive community engagement.
- 4 The Governor-General will be accompanied on the visit by Dr Richard Davies and two Government House staff (the Official Secretary and an Aide-de-Camp) and two Protection Service officers.

#### Travel

5 The Governor-General and accompanying officials will travel to and from Samoa on commercial flights.

#### **Financial implications**

- 6 The cost of the visit is approximately <sup>\$9(2)(f)(iv)</sup> The costs comprise <sup>\$9(2)(f)(iv)</sup> for flights and <sup>\$9(2)(f)(iv)</sup> for accommodation and incidental expenses for the official party from Government House, excluding the Protection Service officers.
- 7 The costs for the Governor-General and party will be met from the permanent legislative authority in Vote Prime Minister and Cabinet for the travel expenses of the Governor-General under section 14 of the Governor-General Act 2010.
  - The expenses of the Protection Service officers will be met from Vote Police.

#### Consultation

9 The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade has been consulted in the development and implementation of the Governor-General's programme and this Cabinet paper.

11 During the absence of the Governor-General from 4 to 8 September 2022 the Chief Justice, Rt Hon Dame Helen Winkelmann, will act as Administrator of the Government.

#### Recommendations

It is recommended that Cabinet:

- 1. **note** that the Governor-General will be absent from New Zealand from 4 to 8 September 2022 to undertake a visit to Samoa;
- 2. **note** that the Governor-General will be accompanied by Dr Richard Davies, the Official Secretary, and an Aide-de-Camp from Government House, and two Protection Service officers;
- 3. **note** that the total cost of the visit for the Governor-General's party from Government House to the Samoa will be approximately <sup>s9(2)(f)(iv)</sup>
- 4. **note** that these costs will be met from the appropriation under permanent legislative authority in Vote Prime Minister and Cabinet for the travel expenses of the Governor-General under section 14 of the Governor-General Act 2010; however, the travel expenses of the two Protection Service officers will be met from Vote Police;
- 5. **note** that in the absence of the Governor-General from 4 to 8 September 2022 the Chief Justice, Rt Hon Dame Helen Winkelmann, will act as Administrator of the Government.

## **Overseas Travel: Governor-General**

On 29 August 2022, Cabinet:

- 1 **noted** that the Governor-General will be absent from Aotearoa New Zealand from 4 to 8 September 2022 to undertake a visit to Samoa;
- 2 **noted** that the Governor-General will be accompanied by Dr Richard Davies, the Official Secretary, and an Aide-de-Camp from Government House;
- 3 **noted** that the total cost of the visit for the Governor-General's party from Government House to Samoa will be approximately  $\frac{s9(2)(f)(iv)}{iv}$
- 4 **noted** that the above costs will be met from the appropriation under permanent legislative authority in Vote Prime Minister and Cabinet for the travel expenses of the Governor-General under section 14 of the Governor-General Act 2010;
- 5 **noted** that the Governor-General's party will also be accompanied by two Protection Service officers, whose travel expenses will be met from Vote Police;
- 6 **noted** that in the absence of the Governor-General from 4 to 8 September 2022 the Chief Justice, Rt Hon Dame Helen Winkelmann, will act as Administrator of the Government.
