Purpose

1. This aide memoire provides a brief update on the testing innovation work programme.

Regulatory workstream

Rapid review

- The rapid review of Point-of-Care Testing (POCT) began Monday 4 July and is expected to be complete by mid-August. Manatū Hauora has received Allen + Clarke's draft report and provided comments this week.

Wider regulatory review

- 5. Manatū Hauora is undertaking a desktop scan of relevant documents on testing and innovation and has developed a draft skeleton for the wider regulatory review report, which is being used to shape and guide further research and analysis.
- 6. A report on this work will be provided in November. This will include recommendations on how this work can be incorporated into the Therapeutic Products Bill.

Innovation and futures workstream

- DPMC received a draft report on the workshops and survey from PwC on 1 August. Due to staff sickness and competing priorities this week, DPMC has not been able to engage with PwC on the report in order to finalise it.
- Once the PwC report is finalised, DPMC is planning to have a draft paper ready to go to other stakeholder agencies for comment (including Callaghan Innovation), prior to finalising the paper in August.
