## Additional Item: Extension of the State of National Emergency

Portfolios Prime Minister / Civil Defence

On 14 April 2020, Cabinet:

- noted that the current state of national emergency in response to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on New Zealand expires on 15 April 2020 at 12.21 pm, and that it must be extended before this time to remain in place for a further seven days;
- 2 **noted** that the Minister of Civil Defence intends to extend the duration of the state of national emergency under the Civil Defence Emergency Management Act 2002 for a further seven days from 15 April 2020.
