#### Background

- Within Vote Prime Minister and Cabinet (PMC), the COVID-19 Response portfolio received funding through the COVID-19 Response and Recovery Fund (CRRF) for the establishment of a business group within the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (DPMC) to lead and coordinate the all-of-government COVID-19 response effort.
- Funding has been provided to ensure a coordinated all-of-government response to COVID-19 until June 2023.
- Cabinet directed departments receiving CRRF funding to provide a quarterly report to the Treasury detailing the following information:
  - how much has been spent;
  - · progress against key milestones; and
  - forecast future expenditure on these initiatives or programmes.
- 4. In addition, Cabinet also directed officials from DPMC to ensure contracts engaged to fulfil this initiative be structured in a way that enables them to be terminated quickly and funding returned to the Crown [CAB-21-MIN-0487].
- 5. A report has been developed to address these Cabinet directives.
- Responsibility for the vaccine campaign transferred to Te Whatu Ora on 1 July 2022. All other contracts are scheduled for novation to key agencies during Quarter 2 2022/23 in accordance with decisions by responsible Ministers in October 2022.

#### Quarter 1 2022/23 update

- 7. The Quarter 1 CRRF report for funding appropriated within Vote PMC is provided for your approval (Attachment A).
- 8. It sets out that:
  - from 1 July 2022 to 30 September 2022, \$8.433 million has been spent from Vote PMC;
  - 58% of New Zealanders said they had access to all the information they want and need about COVID-19.
- Following a tender process, DPMC entered into new contracts with Clemenger BBDO Limited and OMD New Zealand Limited for the Unite Against COVID-19 campaign. The Quarter 1 report for the 2022/23 year reflects these contract arrangements.

#### Quarter 2 2022/23 focus

10. DPMC will focus on transfer of responsibilities and funding to agencies as agreed by responsible Ministers.

#### Next steps

#### **COVID-19 Response and Recovery Fund**

As requested as part of the Budget 22 process attached, as Annex A, is a progress report on spending to date of funding allocated in this portfolio from the COVID-19 Response and Recovery Fund (CRRF) within Vote Prime Minister and Cabinet (PMC).

Please note that reporting on vaccine campaign expenditure for the 2022/23 year is the responsibility of the Ministry of Health as part of its CRRF reporting, while delivery of the campaign is carried out by Te Whatu Ora.

Following agreement by responsible Ministers, all other contracts and advertising responsibilities will transfer to other agencies, along with associated CRRF funding, during Quarter 2 2022/23. This leaves a small residual function within the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet.
