REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE REVIEW PANEL

CANTERBURY EARTHQUAKE (RESOURCE MANAGEMENT ACT PORT OF LYTTELTON RECOVERY) ORDER 2011

- 1. On 10 May 2011 the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Review Panel (the Review Panel) considered the above draft Order (version PCO 15245/1.3).
- 2. The Review Panel considered the letter from Kevin Currie, Ministry for the Environment letter dated 6 May and noted that the objective of the proposal is to facilitate recovery of:
 - a. the Port of Lyttelton from earthquake damage it has suffered by providing additional space for its use that is consistent with the long-term development plan of the Port of Lyttelton; and
- b.the Christchurch Central Business District and the Port Hills areas by providing a permanent place where suitable rubble and rock-fall may be deposited.
- 3. The Review Panel is of the view that the draft Order is necessary, expedient and meets the purpose of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011.

Recommendation

4. The Review Panel recommends that clause 7(3) of the draft Order be amended to include the Lyttleton-Mt Herbert Community Board. This will allow for the Community Board to be consulted by the Lyttleton Port Company and a summary of the Community Board's views to be included in the application(s) made to the relevant consent authorities.
