### REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE REVIEW PANEL

# CANTERBURY EARTHQUAKE (INLAND REVENUE ACTS) AMENDMENT ORDER 2012

- 1. On 5 March 2012 the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Review Panel (the Review Panel) considered the Canterbury Earthquake (Inland Revenue Acts) Amendment Order 2012 (version PCO 15716/2.0).
- 2. The Review Panel considered the letter from Peter Frawley from Inland Revenue dated 2 March 2012.
- 3. The Review Panel noted that the Order in Council will extend the effect of the existing Canterbury Earthquake (Inland Revenue Acts) Order 2011 for a further six months under section 71 of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011.
- 4. This draft Order allows the Commissioner of Inland Revenue to extend a time limit specified in tax legislation if a person is, or has been, unable to comply with an original time limit because of the Canterbury earthquakes.

5. The Review Panel is of the view that the draft Order is necessary, expedient and meets the purposes of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011.

## **Recommendation**

1. The Review Panel recommends to the Minister of Revenue that the Canterbury Earthquake (Inland Revenue Acts) Amendment Order 2012 (version PCO 15716/2.0) be made without change.
