The Prime Minister received four additional briefings within this timeframe. I am not releasing the titles of these briefings, in accordance with the following sections of the Act:

- section 6(a), to protect the security or defence of New Zealand or the international relations of New Zealand
- section 9(2)(g)(i), to maintain the effective conduct of public affairs through the free and frank expression of opinion.

Also identified were a number of briefings provided by the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet's Policy Advisory Group to the Prime Minister. These briefings are provided to the Prime Minister in confidence to support him in his role as leader of the Government and chair of Cabinet. The titles of these briefings are withheld in their entirety under the following sections of the Act:

- section 6(a), to protect the security or defence of New Zealand or the international relations of New Zealand
- section 9(2)(f)(ii), to maintain collective and individual ministerial responsibility
- section 9(2)(f)(iv), to maintain the confidentiality of advice tendered by or to Ministers and officials
- section 9(2)(g)(i), to maintain the effective conduct of public affairs through the free and frank expression of opinion
- Section 9(2)(h), to maintain legal privilege.

In making my decision, I have considered the public interest considerations in section 9(1) of the Act. No public interest has been identified that would be sufficient to outweigh the reasons for withholding that information.

You have the right to ask the Ombudsman to investigate and review my decision under section 28(3) of the Act.

This response will be published on the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet's website during our regular publication cycle. Typically, information is released monthly, or as otherwise determined. Your personal information including name and contact details will be removed for publication.
