Official Information Act request relating to the Emergency Mobile Alerts issued on 30 July and 31 July 2025

Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) request received on 31 July 2025. You requested:

“1) Decision-Making Meetings and Attendance

- a) Was a formal or informal meeting held to decide whether to issue the EMAs?*
- b) If no meeting was held, what form of communication occurred between decision making parties to issue the EMAs?*
- c) Please provide:*
 - i) The date and time of any meeting(s) and/or communications*
 - ii) The names and roles of those present or involved (in person or remotely)*
 - iii) Any minutes, notes, briefings, or agendas from these meeting(s)/communications, including records of any decisions made.*

2) Authorisation and Approval

- a) Who ultimately gave the authorisation or approval to issue the EMAs?*
- b) Please provide any documentation, including emails, text messages, signal messages, slack messages (or other messaging systems) or internal communications relating to this authorisation.*

3) Timing of the Alert

- a) Why was the time of approximately 6:30am chosen for the alert on 31 July 2025*

Part 1 and 5 – decision-making

The Emergency Mobile Alert (EMA) system is governed by strict protocol on its use. The [Emergency Mobile Alert Protocol for User Agencies](#) document covers the criteria for sending Emergency Mobile Alerts to New Zealanders. The National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) will only send alerts when there is a severe, urgent and likely threat to life, health or property. Dangerous tsunami activity generated by the Kamchatka earthquake affecting New Zealand's coastline clearly met these criteria, and the decision to use it was informed by scientific advice and consultation with Civil Defence Emergency Management Groups.

In respect of emergency management, NEMA has a statutory responsibility to alert the public to tsunami risk. Every decision to alert the public is based on best advice available including scientific evidence, international best practice, the observable conditions, and the life safety risks.

When NEMA received notification that a powerful earthquake had occurred and generated tsunami waves that were travelling across the Pacific, it was a straightforward decision to alert people to help them stay safe.

Based on advice from Earth Sciences NZ that tsunami activity would arrive at our shores around midnight on Wednesday evening (30 July), NEMA issued a National Advisory and sent an Emergency Mobile Alert. As always, we carefully selected who should receive it - in this case, the alert was only sent to phones connected to a mobile tower near the coastline. The first alert was sent at 4.13pm as it was critical to issue it before nightfall, because many people live on boats, or plan ahead for early fishing trips or a dawn surf.

Overnight, we received confirmation that tsunami activity was impacting New Zealand's coastline and would continue to do so well into Thursday (31 July). We weighed up the risks and concluded that we needed to inform the public that the threat was present and ongoing. We sent the alert at 6.30am to ensure we did not wake large numbers of people up in the middle of the night, while informing those planning morning activities in beach or marine areas while dangerous tsunami activity was happening.

Parts 2, 3 and 4 – Authorisation and internal communications

I am refusing your request for who authorised the alert under section 9(2)(g)(ii) of the Act, to prevent improper pressure or harassment.

I am releasing to you all internal communications relating to the alerts of 30 and 31 July 2025. Some information is withheld under section 9(2)(g)(i) of the Act, to maintain the effective conduct of public affairs through the free and frank expression of opinion and section 9(2)(g)(ii) of the Act as highlighted above.

In addition, I am releasing a summary of the discussions with the Tsunami Expert Panel relating to this event. This includes discussion around the timing of the alert on 31 July 2025.

In making my decision, I have considered the public interest considerations in section 9(1) of the Act. No public interest has been identified that would be sufficient to override the reasons for withholding that information.

Part 6 – alert fatigue

Below is an excerpt of the relevant parts of an internal advice document titled “*HRM Briefing Note – Early Warning Best Practice May 2025*” which relates to alert fatigue:

There are several key factors to consider when determining how, and when to issue warnings. One of these is the risk of warning fatigue, often called the ‘cry-wolf effect’. Warning fatigue is the loss in credibility of a warning system and subsequently, the warning agency, due to false alarms. The risk of warning fatigue may need to be considered alongside the consequences of perceived ‘missed alerts’, which occur when the public believe they should have been warned for an event and did not receive a warning.

Recommended mitigation techniques for decreasing the risk of warning fatigue include raising the trigger level for issuing warnings to decrease the number issued, transparent communication of any uncertainty relating to the event and, if required, communicating clearly why a false alarm occurred^[1].

Position

Aotearoa New Zealand is continuously working to improve its early warning systems, and public education arrangements that maximise the effectiveness of warnings. NEMA encourages cautious and considered approaches to improving early warning systems that will help to protect communities during events when there is a risk to life, property or infrastructure. Aotearoa New Zealand supports international principles for EWS and NEMA has identified areas where we can improve our EWS, such as increasing our focus on multi-hazard warning systems and ensuring that both the messaging and dissemination methods are useable for everyone.

NEMA’s connections with the technology sector enable us to stay informed of, and advocate for, technological innovations that could improve our ability to disseminate warnings for events. Additionally, NEMA’s networks with the science and research communities provide opportunities to inform, and maintain awareness of, the projects and research programmes that will underpin advancements in monitoring, forecasting and warning for hazard risks.

*Regarding the use of EMAs, NEMA maintains the position that the EMA system should only be used to issue **High-Priority Alerts**. In accordance with the New Zealand Common Alerting Protocol (CAP-NZ), High-Priority Alerts are at level (a) or (b) within each of the following three criterion:*

1. *Certainty*
 - a. *Observed: Determined to have occurred or to be ongoing*
 - b. *Likely: Probability of its occurrence greater than 50%*
2. *Severity*
 - a. *Extreme: Extraordinary threat to life, health or property*
 - b. *Severe: Significant threat to life, health or property*
3. *Urgency*
 - a. *Immediate: Responsive action should be taken immediately*
 - b. *Expected: Responsive action should be taken soon.*

The criteria is set at a high threshold because of the risk of warning fatigue, as noted in Background, resulting in a lower likelihood of public response, and a reduction in level of trust in warning agencies. This risk presents a serious concern for emergency managers, as trust in both the warning agency and the technology is an important factor in ensuring any warning is effective^{[2][3]}. In the case of an imminent, high impact threat where EMA is the only effective warning mechanism available, a low response rate poses an increased risk to life.

If agencies are looking to implement significant changes to their warning systems, often prompted by a major event and subsequent reviews, it is recommended that the warning agency first assesses the risks associated with changing the system. Key risks include increasing warning fatigue if the warning threshold is lowered, causing public confusion if education on the new system is insufficient, or misaligning with national standards and consistent approaches. Alternative solutions should be considered, such as enhancing public awareness and preparedness by increasing hazard risk and impact messaging on communication channels, as widely and early as possible, or investigating possible alternative alerting methods, to complement existing systems.

Regarding the frequency of the alerts, we acknowledge that some people's phones sounded multiple alerts in the middle of the night, even though NEMA had only issued two alerts. We are still investigating the cause or causes of this. To date, our investigations have confirmed the multiple alerts were highly unlikely to have been generated at the NEMA sender end, as NEMA only issued alerts at two times – 4.13pm on Wednesday 30 July, and 6.30am on Thursday 31 July.

Emergency Mobile Alerts are issued to a multitude of different devices, and we are aware that some devices may occasionally behave differently despite receiving the same message at the same time. NEMA apologises to those impacted by the multiple alerts for the inconvenience and disruption this caused.

Summary of TEP and National Controller Discussions Kamchatka Earthquake and Tsunami 30 July – 4 August 2025

Overview

The Tsunami Expert Panel (TEP) provides the scientific analysis for tsunami risk to New Zealand and is hosted by Earth Sciences New Zealand (ESNZ).

This is delivered via two mechanisms:

- Advice provided by ESNZ's National Geohazard Monitoring Centre (NGMC) directly to NEMA's Monitoring, Alerting and Reporting (MAR) Centre. This includes the forecast maps and Event Arrival Time information.
- Phone calls between the TEP and the National Controller to discuss the analysis, forward assessments, and to provide the opportunity to ask questions. This helps inform NEMA's decision making.

A total of 10 phone calls were conducted between the TEP and NEMA for this event, summarised below.

30 July 1335hrs

The EQ is expected to be upgraded from 8.7M to 8.3M. The modelling is indicating a beach and marine threat for the entire country, including the Chatham Islands. The Chatham Islands is likely to receive the strongest tsunami waves, getting close to a land threat at 0.8m.

The modelling is not currently showing a land threat, but it remains a possibility. They will stick with a beach and marine threat assessment for now, noting the next update is likely to include actual data, as well as modelling.

30 July 1940hrs

Still expecting to see beach and marine impacts, including the Chatham Islands, but the Scientist in Charge overnight will contact me if this looks like it will escalate to a land threat.

The first wave arrivals are expected around midnight, and the DART Buoys will give an early indication of their arrival from around 9pm. They may indicate an earlier de-escalation for the West Coast but there is likely to be some beach and marine threat for parts of the country going well into tomorrow. The picture will become clearer overnight.

30 July 2300hrs

No change to the threat area being all of New Zealand coasts for beach and marine. The models are looking good with the data matching the models across the Pacific. The current threat model will now remain in place until midday tomorrow.

It is expected there will be de-escalation from midday through to midnight, zone by zone, starting on the West Coast. Some areas could remain under threat for as long as two days from the earthquake occurring.

31 July 0845hrs

No change to the current threat map and it remains valid until midday.

Tsunami gauges around New Zealand are showing tsunami waves, some as high as 30cm, therefore they could be higher along the coast. The Chatham Islands data is as 50cm and increasing. Dunedin is also increasing.

Some de-escalation can be expected from midday. Wellington is expected to experience waves for longer, while Kapiti may de-escalate earlier.

31 July 1150hrs

Continues to be the same level of threat for the whole country. Criteria for de-escalation for the west coasts of both islands is expected to be met around mid-afternoon.

The Chatham Islands modelling is showing similar arrivals to earlier to arrive overnight. Expecting to receive reflections off South America, possibly overnight for the East Coast.

31 July 1500hrs

The tide gauges for the west coast of the South Island are measuring at just below beach and marine thresholds.

The west coast of the North Island is trending down. The east coast of both islands is expected to receive reflections from South America. There will be a lull and it will pick up again overnight.

31 July 1900hrs

De-escalation of most of the west coast of the South Island. Things haven't changed a lot, it's stable and satisfied it's not going to get any worse. Waiting on reflections on South America to arrive and there could still be spots that exceed the 30cm beach and marine threshold. It is expected that more zones will be de-escalated tomorrow morning.

1 Aug 0745hrs

All of New Zealand has had its threat de-escalated, except for the Chatham Islands. The largest wave arrivals on the Chatham Islands have been from the reflected waves off South America. Beach and marine tsunami conditions were observed on the east coast of the South Island overnight, with the largest waves heights in Gisborne.

There remains a low level of activity across the east coast, but below the beach and marine threat threshold.

1 Aug 1250hrs

All of New Zealand has been de-escalated and there is no longer considered to be a beach and marine threat.

Strong currents are still expected to be observed over the weekend, but the tsunami threat has passed. The TEP is standing down for the weekend.

4 Aug 1020hrs

Strong currents were observed over the weekend and all activity has now passed. The TEP is closing the event.

Philippines cancels tsunami advisory issued across the country

The Philippines has canceled a tsunami advisory that was issued for several coastal communities across the country.

"No significant sea level disturbances nor destructive tsunami waves have been recorded since the 7:25 a.m. (NZ 1:25pm) earthquake," the Philippines Institute of Volcanology and Seismology said in its latest update.

The institute had previously warned the public to stay away from the coast and to move inland because tsunami waves were expected to hit coastal areas of the country.

"Any effects due to minor sea level disturbances have largely passed," it said when cancelling the advisory.

Issue an updated National Advisory at 0530, and re-issue the EMA at 0600.

The next NEMA/CDEM meeting will be at 0830 tomorrow morning (I will send out the invite shortly).

Ensure the key point about the threat remaining until midday tomorrow, with a likely de-escalation from midday to midnight, and that some areas may remain under threat until midday Friday, is included in the update to [REDACTED] and myself, so that he and the Minister are able to talk to this in their media interviews.

Morning all, without wanting to come across as too defensive - there is no indication from telco's that there has been any 'glitch'. We're well aware that phones can receive the alert multiple times for a variety of reasons. Switching from 3/4g, switching towers for better reception, a tower coming online for capacity reasons or just a phone updating and reconnecting to the network can cause this. There will be those on the cusp of the alerting area who will have received the message repeatedly for the 12 hours that we broadcast. 




