Official Information Act request relating to Funding to Te Arawa/Ngati Whakaue

Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) request, which was received by the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (DPMC) on 3 November 2025. You requested:

We can only respond to your request under the Act with information that the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (DPMC) holds. Te Arawa/Ngāti Whakaue is not subject to the Act, therefore we are not able to transfer part [1] of your request to them for response under the Act. Therefore, this part of your request is refused under section 18(g) of the Act, as the information is not held by the department or Minister of the Crown or organisation we have no grounds for believing that the information is either held by another department or Minister of the Crown or organisation.

Regarding part [2] of your request, DPMC has not paid any grants, subsidies or funding to any of the trusts you have listed above.

You have the right to ask the Ombudsman to investigate and review my decision under section 28(3) of the Act.
