Official Information Act request relating to Five Eyes meeting and communications

Thank you for your request made under the Official Information Act (the Act), received on 18 December 2025. You requested:

- 1. Any records of a Five Eyes intelligence principals gathering May 2025, code-named "Gold Sycamore".*
- 2. Any records of dpmc communication (non-confidential) with the governments or diplomatic representatives of the United States, Australia, Canada, or New Zealand regarding concerns over the reliability or resource allocation of the FBI under its new leadership, particularly as it relates to Five Eyes cooperation.*

The Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (DPMC) does not hold information in relation to part [1] of your request, but I believe the Government Communications Security Bureau (GCSB) and New Zealand Security Intelligence Service (NZSIS) may hold relevant information.

Accordingly, I have decided to transfer this part of your request to the GCSB under section 14(b)(i) of the Act. Normally, I would also partially transfer part [1] of your request to NZSIS; however, I am advised you made the same request under the Act to NZSIS, and I therefore refer you to their response.

The GCSB has the usual timeframes under the Act from receipt of this transfer to make a decision on your request.

Part [2] of your request is refused under section 18(e) of the Act, as the information requested does not exist.

This response will be published on the DPMC website during our regular publication cycle. Typically, information is released monthly, or as otherwise determined. Your personal information including name and contact details will be removed for publication.
