Official Information Act request relating to 2025 Trilateral Pacific security cooperation dialogue

Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) request, which was received by the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (DPMC) on 3 March 2026. You requested:

“Under the Official Information Act, please supply all formal briefings prepared for, and all formal reports arising from, the 2025 Australia—United States—New Zealand Trilateral Pacific Security Cooperation Dialogue, noting this request is for information held by the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (DPMC) only.”

DPMC does not hold any briefings for, or reports arising from, the 2025 Trilateral Pacific security cooperation dialogue. As you have requested information held by DPMC, I am refusing your request under section 18(e) of the Act, on the basis that the requested information does not exist.
