Official Information Act request relating to When a Tribunal is set to hear claims against the crown

Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) request, which was received by the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (DPMC) on 18 May 2026. You requested:

“Please advise when a Tribunal is set to hear claims against the crown by European new Zealanders.”

The information you are seeking is not held by Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet. I am refusing your request under section 18(g) of the Act, which provides that the information requested is not held by the department or Minister of the Crown and the person dealing with the request has no grounds for believing that the information is either held by another agency or Minister of the Crown or connected more closely with the functions of another department or Minister of the Crown.

If you are seeking information that you believe may be held by another agency, you may wish to consider making a request direct to that agency (if you have not done so already). You have the right to ask the Ombudsman to investigate and review my decision under section 28(3) of the Act.
